Day 1

WELCOME TO ULAANBAATAR



- Arrive in Ulaanbaatar and meet your guide and driver
- Transfer to your centrally located hotel
- Experience a mix of modern city life and historic traditions
- Stay within walking distance of Sukhbaatar Square
- Explore nearby museums and local shops
- Settle in and take some time to relax
- Enjoy a short city orientation tour
- Head out for dinner in the evening
- Get your first feel of the city's atmosphere
- Overnight at the hotel

Day 2

NAADAM FESTIVAL EXPERIENCE

- Spend the day at Mongolia's famous Naadam Festival
- Experience a celebration of tradition, strength, and culture
- Watch bökh (traditional wrestling) in action
- See skilled archers compete with precision
- Learn how these traditions shaped Mongolia's history
- In the afternoon, head to Khui Doloon Khudag
- Watch long-distance horse races across the open steppe
- See young riders race with incredible skill
- Take in the energy of Mongolia's nomadic spirit
- Overnight in a ger camp near Moltsoog Els



Itinerary

Day 3

DRIVE TO TSETSERLEG VIA HARHORIN



- Drive from Ulaanbaatar toward Harhorin
- Learn about its past as the Mongol Empire's capital
- Visit Erdene Zuu Monastery, founded in 1586
- Explore one of Mongolia's oldest Buddhist sites
- Continue west to Tsetserleg in Arkhangai Province
- Take in forests, rivers, and mountain landscapes
- Arrive at camp in the Ikh Tamir River valley
- Meet local wranglers and your horses
- Get your first feel of Mongolia's horse culture
- Overnight at camp

Day 4 - 9

HORSEBACK TREK THROUGH ARKHANGAI

- Set out on a multi-day horseback journey
- Ride through valleys, forests & mountain passes
- Take in wide-open views of Mongolia's wilderness
- Travel with support from a gear vehicle
- Ride with experienced local wranglers
- Cover steady distances at a comfortable pace
- Option to rest in the support vehicle anytime
- Visit nomadic families along the way
- Enjoy local foods like yogurt, cheese, and airag
- Camp in comfortable tents each night

Day 10

KHOGNO KHAN NATIONAL PARK



- Drive to Khogno Khan National Park
- Begin the final stretch of your journey
- Take a peaceful hike through unique rock formations
- Explore the area around Khogno Khan Mountain
- Visit the ruins of Uvgun Temple (built in 1660)
- Walk through a scenic landscape rich in history
- Slow down and enjoy the quiet surroundings
- Take in views where steppe, mountains, and desert meet
- Settle into your ger camp
- Overnight under star-filled skies

Day 11

RETURN TO ULAANBAATAR & CULTURE

- Drive back to Ulaanbaatar through scenic landscapes
- Arrive in the city and settle in
- Head out to a local folk theater
- Watch live performances of music, dance and acrobatics
- Experience traditional throat singing
- Take in Mongolia's rich cultural traditions
- Enjoy a farewell dinner with your group
- Share highlights and memories from the trip
- Overnight at the hotel

ULAANBAATAR CITY & HISTORY



- Start your day with breakfast at the hotel
- Head out for a guided city tour
- Visit Zaisan Memorial for sweeping city views
- Take in the scenery from Bogd Khan Mountain
- Walk through Sukhbaatar Square
- See the statue of Damdin Sukhbaatar
- Get a feel for the city's history and daily life
- Visit the National History Museum
- Learn about Mongolia's past, from empires to nomadic culture
- Return to your hotel and relax for the evening
- Overnight at the hotel

- Enjoy your final morning in Mongolia
- Meet your guide and driver for your transfer
- Head to the airport for your departure
- Check in and prepare for your flight home
- Board your onward journey
